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# b. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer reported that, as of September 10, 2019 the cash balance was \$1,326,183.03 and the estimated unpaid bills amount to \$10,124.50. The total fees and costs incurred through August 2019 for the Reef Group litigation amounts to \$479,947.10, and \$204,814.93 for the Factor/Arnault litigation, and \$452,198.28 for the Validation Action.

The Treasurer further reported that \$1,000,000 out of the \$3,500,000 monies invested will become due in October 2019.

The Chair recognized Jim Hornstein, a legal representative for the Reef Group, who suggested that, if the BBGHAD rolls significant funds into a one-year CD, and the BBGHAD would be required to issue refunds, that it would incur possible penalties if the available funds are not enough to cover the refund amount.

The Chair directed Treasurer and Project Manager to survey interest rates at federally-insured institutions for Certificates of Deposit not to exceed one year.
